

Feed Back of CME on Management of Paediatric Emergencies Held on 26th November 2016

A total of 60 persons attend the CME, out of whom 45 gave feedback. Parameter wise feedback received is given below: -

1. Whether Content was appropriate? – 33 participants agreed strongly. Only 1 disagreed completely.
2. Whether the CME was job related for the participants? – 41 strongly agreed. 3 disagreed completely.
3. Will you recommend this CME to others? – 42 agreed strongly. 2 disagreed.
4. Whether the CME was well managed? – 30 strongly agreed. 11 agreed somewhat. 3 disagreed completely.
5. Whether communication was good? – 38 agreed strongly. 3 agreed somewhat. 3 disagreed completely.
6. Whether study material was good? – 25 agreed strongly. 13 agreed somewhat. 3 disagreed completely.
7. Whether instructors were knowledgeable? – 41 agreed strongly. 3 disagreed completely.
8. Will you attend a follow up CME? – 39 agreed strongly. 4 agreed somewhat. 2 disagreed completely.
9. Length of the CME – 37 participants said that it was the Right Length, 1 said that it was Too Long and 7 said that it was too short.
10. Level of CME – 9 participants thought that it was advanced level, 29 thought that it was Intermediate level and 7 thought that it was introductory.
11. Quality of Visuals – 9 participants felt that visuals were excellent, 23 found them to be very good, 9 thought that they were good, 3 said they were poor and 1 participant felt that the visuals were very poor.
12. Acoustics – 8 participants felt that the acoustics were excellent, 19 felt they were very good, 17 said that acoustics were good and 1 said that acoustics were very poor.
13. Workshop space – 16 participants said that it was excellent, 17 felt that it was very good, 9 felt it was good and 3 felt that it was very poor.
14. Handouts – Handout were not given in the CME. The course material is uploaded on the website for all participants to download.
15. Overall Impression – 19 participants felt that it was excellent, 14 felt that it was very good, 11 said that it was good and 1 felt that it was poor.
