

So, the world must toe the line**






**For we're lofty and of solemn import

# Rajni Sekhri Sibal

Rajni Sekhri Sibal is an Indian Administrative Officer of the Haryana cadre who has recently superannuated as Secretary, Government of India. She is of the 1986 Batch and is the first lady to have topped the All India Civil Service Examinations. She is the recipient of the Indian of the Year 2013 Award in the category 'Unsung Hero' for her courage and commitment.

In her last assignment with Government of India, Rajni was posted as the first Secretary of the recently created Ministry of Fisheries prior to which she worked as Additional Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, and Additional Secretary, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. In a previous assignments Rajni worked as a Joint Secretary in the Ministry of Agriculture and Director Health Insurance Max India as well as in the Government of Haryana.

Rajni holds a Master's degree in Psychology as well as Economics and has authored several books: 'Tools for Monitoring'; 'Clouds End and Beyond'; an anthology of verses; 'Kamadhenu'; 'Fragrant Words' – an anthology; 'Are You Prepared for a Disaster?' – a book on Disaster Risk Reduction; as well as 'The Haunting Himalayas'.
